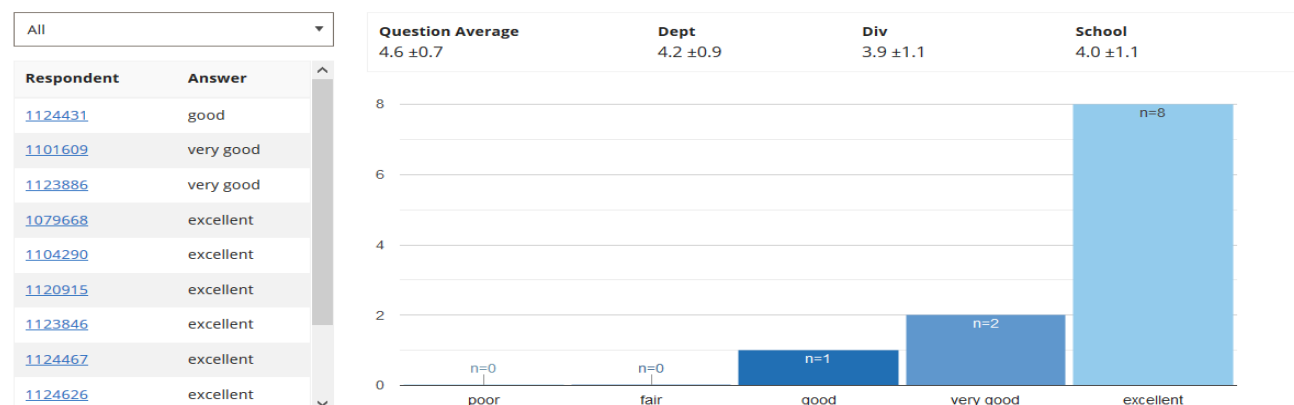
Respondent	Answer

She was critical but fair in her grading, and made it very clear how I could improve my work. In her grading of the reading responses, she encouraged my thinking and also pushed me to think even more deeply about the class, connecting the theorists to the practical case studies. She met with each student one-on-one as we developed our final papers, providing useful theorists relevant to our ideas and also guiding us through the structure. In the week that Anne Marie led the course, she gave us a reading guide to structure our thinking about the readings. Everyone was extremely engaged and excited to discuss her ideas. The one thing that she could have improved upon is simple but crucial-- sometimes she would ask a question, and no one would respond right away. From my experience teaching, I know how uncomfortable that silence is, but if Anne Marie had waited just a bit longer (not clarifying the question, just waiting) I think we would have been able to think through a response and engage. I think that Anne Marie will be an incredible prof in the not-so-distant future, her students will be lucky to have her.
